



During your recent endoscopy, your doctor performed a WATS^{3D} biopsy. This is an advanced technique that can help detect precancerous cells before they develop into esophageal cancer. The WATS^{3D} procedure ordered by your doctor is proprietary and is available only at CDx Diagnostics, Inc. (CDx).

The laboratory fee

CDx directly bills your medical insurance carrier for its analysis. CDx is currently in the process of becoming an in-network provider with most medical insurance plans. In the meantime, you will not be responsible for out-of-network fees associated with these costs.

What this means for you



In-network plans: If CDx has a contract with your medical insurance carrier, we are contractually obligated to bill standard co-pays, co-insurance, and/or deductibles that your plan views as patient responsibility. These plans include Medicare and Medicare Advantage.



Out-of-network plans: If CDx does not have a contract with your medical insurance carrier, you will not be responsible for amounts that your insurance plan does not cover. Out-of-network insurance carriers have been notified about our billing policy.

Following the WATS^{3D} procedure, you will receive an explanation of benefits (EOB) from your insurance carrier.

The EOB is not a bill. If we are required to collect a payment from you, please wait to make a payment until after you have received an invoice from CDx.

In addition, some insurance carriers will send payments for CDx laboratory services directly to you as the insured/policyholder. If you receive a payment from your insurance carrier for our services, you do not need to wait for an invoice. Instead, you should simply forward that payment with a copy of the EOB to:
